

USC Materials Standards for Events

This document lays out standards for to-go food and beverage materials at USC. All service-ware must either be COMPOSTABLE or RECYCLABLE (as defined for USC below).

Definitions for USC Events:

- Compostable: Uncoated papers (cellulose fibers such as trees, bagasse, potato, banana leaf)
 - NO glossy, colored or waxed paper products.
 - NO compostable PLA- #7 plastics
 - Materials must be Certified Compostable. Acceptable product certifications include:
 - ASTM D-6400, BPI, Cedar Grove
- <u>Recyclable:</u> Clean and empty paper, metal, and glass materials. Single-use plastic beverage bottles are prohibited in compliance with <u>USC's Single-use Plastic Elimination—Beverage Bottles Policy</u>.

Compliance Checklist:

Reusable/refillable food and beverage options should be used whenever possible.

Cutlery	is certified compostable
0	Wooden or paper based

Excludes white and black napkins

Items To Avoid:

• Styrofoam, Plastic to-go bags (including compostable plastic bags), "Recyclable" paper cups

Tips:

Don't stock bundles of items

Only brown napkins

- Ex. Packages that have spoon, fork, knife, salt/pepper & napkin oftentimes people will only use 1 or 2 items and dispose of the rest
- Stock to-go items that are the same materials
 - Ex. Compostable fiber-based bowl with compostable fiber-based lid instead of fiber-based bowl with recyclable plastic lid
- Stock only plastics #1 (PETE), 2 (HDPE) & 5 (PP)
 - o These are the only types of plastic accepted by our waste hauler for recycling
- No compostable or biodegradable plastic products
