

# **USC Materials Standards for Events**

This document lays out standards for to-go food and beverage materials at USC. All service-ware must either be REUSABLE, COMPOSTABLE or RECYCLABLE (as defined for USC below).

### **Definitions for USC Events:**

- Reusable: Items made from durable materials that are washable and can be used multiple times (e.g., refillable bottles or cups).
- Compostable: Uncoated papers (cellulose fibers such as trees, bagasse, potato, banana leaf)
  - NO glossy, colored or waxed paper products.
  - o NO compostable PLA- #7 plastics
  - Materials must be Certified Compostable. Acceptable product certifications include:
    - ASTM D-6400, BPI, Cedar Grove
- **Recyclable:** Clean and empty paper, metal, and glass materials. Single-use plastic beverage bottles are prohibited in compliance with USC's Single-use Plastic Elimination—Beverage Bottles Policy.

# Compliance Checklist:

Reusable/refillable food and beverage options should be used whenever possible.

## For beverages:

Beverage products and cups are either:

- o Reusable/refillable containers
- o Aluminum
- o Glass
- Recyclable plastic cup with sip lid
- Uncoated paper fiber or certified compostable products
  - Excludes PLA #7 plastic products and carton beverage products

Lids, drink stirrers and straws are:

- Uncoated paper fiber or wooden options
  - Excludes compostable PLA #7 plastic products

## For Food:

Service-ware is either:

- Reusable products (any material)
- o Compostable- uncoated paper fiber or wooden options (ex. bagasse plates)
  - Excluding PLA #7 plastic products

\_\_\_\_Cutlery is certified compostable

o Wooden or paper based

Napkins

- Only brown napkins
  - Excludes white and black napkins

#### **Items To Avoid:**

• Styrofoam, Plastic to-go bags (including compostable plastic bags), "Recyclable" paper cups

# Tips:

- Don't stock bundles of items
  - Ex. Packages that have spoon, fork, knife, salt/pepper & napkin oftentimes people will only use 1 or 2 items and dispose of the rest
- Stock to-go items that are the same materials
  - Ex. Compostable fiber-based bowl with compostable fiber-based lid instead of fiber-based bowl with recyclable plastic lid
- Stock only plastics #1 (PETE), 2 (HDPE) & 5 (PP)
  - These are the only types of plastic accepted by our waste hauler for recycling
- No compostable or biodegradable plastic products
